--Please observe the signs around the building that have been put there for your safety and convenience.

--A copy of emergency numbers are posted on the doors that you enter in and out of, and on the walls throughout host area

--Doors will not be unlocked for guests to arrive until 5pm and they will be locked again at 10pm. If you need special accommodations made, please let volunteers know in the morning before you leave.

--If you want to smoke, please do so in the designated smoking area by ashtray in parking lot.

--All guest will help with keeping church clean. This includes wiping down tables and sweeping floors after dinner, cleaning up your own areas before you leave a room or bathroom, keeping rooms clean, emptying your own trash, and maintaining the general up keep of the areas provided for your families.

--Parents are responsible for their children at all times.

--If you would like to meet any outside guests (friends and family members who are not in the Family Promise program) please plan to meet them in them off the church premises. No non-family promise guests loitering in parking lot.

--We would appreciate small children being in bed by 8:30, and quiet time after 10 pm.

--Because our cooks need to know how much food to make please use the dinner log to record what time you will be arriving each night. After 7 pm leftover plates will be placed in the fridge for you. Please call if you will be late or absent any evening; Audrea Woll 360-333-7524

--Before leaving the building please use sign out sheet at the door to note when you left and when you will be returning

--If you will not be present on move out Sunday please make a volunteer is informed and your area is cleaned
